## **Steps to Successfully Set Up Your Adobe Premiere Projects:**

- Open Adobe Premiere CC 2017
- On the "Start" Window that Opens, Click the "New Project" Button
  - \*If you closed this window, you will need to go to the top menu bar and click on File>New>Project
- On the "New Project" Window that opens up, you will need to type in the "Name" field your first and last name & the name of the project
- In the "Location" drop down menu, make sure that it is set to the (Adobe>Premiere Pro>11.0) folder that's located in your User Account.
  - \*This should automatically be set when you initially open Adobe Premiere
- Click the "OK" Button
- After the Project Window opens, go to the top menu bar and click on File>New>Sequence to create a new sequence
- On the "New Sequence" Window that opens up, you will see a list of Sequence Presets, You will need to click the arrow next to HDV listed under the "Available Presets" list to open further options
- Now you will need to click on the HDV 720p30 preset
- In the "Sequence Name" field you will need to type in your first and last name & the name of the project
- Above the Source & Program Windows you will see the various modes/workspaces (Assembly, Editing, Color, Effects, Audio, All Panels, Graphics, Libraries, and Metalogging) you can utilize in Adobe Premiere. For our class, make sure that you are clicked on the "Editing" tab
- In the bottom left corner is the "Project Window", if you see that it is clicked on "Media Browser,

- Libraries, Info, Effects, or anything else, click the "Project" tab
- Right Click your Mouse on the "Project" tab and choose "Import" from the menu that appears so that you may bring in all of your images, videos and music for your project. Alternatively, you can also go to File>Import to do the same thing.
